Little by deed dated the 21st day of December 1839 unduly recorded in the Clerk's office of the County Court of Southampton together with the buildings and improvements appurtenances and advantages to the said Lot and piece of land belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the said Lot and piece of Land and the buildings and improvements and advantages of every description belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto unto the said Fiddling J. Mahone his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Fiddling J. Mahone his heirs and assigns forever.
