This Indenture made and executed this day of May A.D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between James Harcum and Temperance ^{his wife} of the first part, and Thomas Vauhan of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of New Hampshire that the said Jas. Harcum and Temperance his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, bargained and sold and by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Vauhan his heirs heirs heirs and assigns all the right title and Interest in the lands allotted the said Jas. Harcum and Temperance his wife as the dower ^{part} of the said Temperance former husbands land to wit Henry Vauhan s^r. To have and to hold the aforesaid land so long as the said Jas. Harcum and Temperance his wife shall have any Interest right title or claim unto the aforesaid land. And the said Jas. Harcum and Temperance his wife do for themselves their heirs heirs and assigns warrant and defend the aforesaid premises free from all the Claims or claims demand or demands of them their heirs heirs heirs and all persons claiming the aforesaid premises under them. Barbours of the other part of the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that the said Thomas P. Rives & Martha A. his wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars current money of N^o. in hand paid or secured to be paid at or before the ensuing & delivery of these presents have bargained and sold & by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said Joseph H. Barbours a certain tract of land containing one hundred and ninety ^{acres} (more or less) bounded by the lands of George B. Long Thomas Riving & others. To have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said Joseph H. Barbours his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Thomas P. Rives & Martha A. his wife have given and do give unto the said Joseph H. Barbours his heirs & assigns free from the Claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do hereunto annexed their hands & seals the day and year first above written.
