There are therefore to release acquit and discharge the said Thomas M^d Dolk dec^d of and from any claims demanded said or in relation of any kind not only as relates to the transactions of my said late Guardian but also as relates to my half of his estate after paying me the said balance due upon his Guardianship Transactions,

This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of January in the year of our Lord 1840 between John M Stewart and Agnes E his wife of the County of Bonaville State of Virginia of the one part and George A W Newsom of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said John M Stewart & wife Agnes E for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and ninety dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Stewart and wife do hereby acknowledge and acquit the said George A W Newsom from further payment in their behalf. Have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey and confirmed unto the said George A W Newsom a certain piece or parcel of Land lying in the said County of Southampton State of Virginia containing 174 acres more or less it being that portion of Land which was allotted to the said Agnes E as one of the Children to distributees of Nath Nicholson dec^d of Southampton State of Virginia of the said John M Stewart & Agnes E his wife in the land which was allotted to the said widow and relict of said Nath Nicholson as her dower in the Land of her dec^d husband the said Nath Nicholson reference being had to the report of the Commissioners who set apart the said Nath's dower and who apportioned the Land of the said Nath Nicholson among his Children to distributees of record in Southampton County the situation & boundaries of said Land as set apart in dower also the number of acres well appear. To have and to hold the piece of Land aforesaid to have the said George A W Newsom his heirs and assigns forever against the claims of themselves or either of their heirs and assigns and do hereby warrant and defend title to the same. In Witness whereof the said parties of the first part have hereunto set their hands & seals the day & date first above written.
