This Indenture made 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and  
fifty eight between Isaac Andrews of the County of Pungo of the first part and H J Harrison of the  
said County of the second part and Henry Pennington of the same County of the third part. Witnesseth that  
whereas the said Isaac Andrews stands justly indebted to the said Henry Pennington in his own right  
and as Executor of Charles Billiams dec<sup>d</sup> and administrator of Solomon R Green deceased in the following named  
sums due by bonds and executed and bearing date as herein mentioned namely one bond executed  
to Charles Billiams the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1836 and was two days after due for one hundred and two  
dollars and 32 cents One other bond executed to Henry Pennington Executor of Charles Billiams dec<sup>d</sup> on  
the third day of May 1836 and due the first day of January 1837 for forty eight dollars and sixty seven cents  
One other bond executed to Henry Pennington on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1836 and due 1<sup>st</sup> January 1837  
for twenty dollars. Three other bonds executed to Henry Pennington from Solomon R Green and for  
Rent of plantation whereon said Green died for forty dollars each first due 25 December 1837 2<sup>d</sup> due  
25<sup>th</sup> Decr 1838 and third due 25<sup>th</sup> Decr 1839 all executed the 25<sup>th</sup> Decr 1836 and whereas the said  
Isaac Andrews is willing and desirous of discharging of the payment of the above named sums of  
Money with the interest that may accrue thereon whenever he shall be thereby required by the aforesaid  
Henry Pennington his heirs or assigns. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Isaac Andrews  
stands in consideration of the promises aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of One  
dollar to him in hand paid by the said H J Harrison the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
by the said Isaac Andrews hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain  
and sell unto the said H J Harrison his heirs and assigns forever the following property namely Thanna  
Brownson Ambrose Joe and Rhoda slaves belonging to the said Isaac Andrews To have and to hold  
the above recited property unto him the said H J Harrison his heirs or assigns to the only proffers  
and behove of him the said H J Harrison his heirs and assigns forever and the said Isaac Andrews  
for himself and his heirs the title to the before granted premises unto the said H J Harrison his heirs  
or assigns against the claims or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will  
curent and forever defend by these presents upon special trust and confidence notwithstanding and it is  
honestly understood and agreed by the parties that in regard of the said Isaac Andrews
