This Indenture made and entered into on this 1st day of February in the year 1820 by and between Matilda Barratt Polly Barratt and Mariach Barratt of the one part and Davis Vick of the other part such and all of said Parties reside in the County of Southampton Virginia this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and ninety dollars to have the said Barratts in hand paid by the said Davis Vick the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged they the said Matilda Barratt Polly Barratt and Mariach Barratt have jointly bargained and sold to him the said Davis Vick his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and estate which we individually and jointly have in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton bounded by the Lands of the following named persons to wit, Thomas Newson on the East William Boyants on the South and Henry Kenderel on the West and North, it being the Land lately owned by Rhoda Barratt and supposed to contain Ninety Eight acres of Land to be the same more or less to him the said Davis Vick his heirs and assigns forever. Nowethly passing to ourselves jointly the quiet possession of two acres of said Land during each and all our natural lives also a sufficiency of wood for one chimney constantly to burn off need require during the term of their natural lives & furthermore said wood to be taken from the said Land there sold at any part thereof where they the said Barratts may chose to take it and be the said Davis Vick. To have and to hold all other covenants to the said Land belonging except those above named free from the claim of the said Matilda Barratt Polly Barratt and Mariach Barratt or either of them or either of their heirs Executors or administrators and also free from the claim of all and every person and persons whomsoever by us or hereby warranted and forever hereafter defended the right and title aforesaid to him the said Davis Vick his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof we and each of us have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year first herein above written as

S. Griffin is willing to secure the punctual payment of the said sum of eighty dollars together with the interest which shall accrue thereon Now therefore the said J. S. Griffin has for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said William D. Clarke at the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and granted which the said W. D. Clarke his heirs Executors and assigns are forever released exonerated and discharged by the said J. S. Griffin have bargained and sold and doth hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said W. D.
