This Indenture made and entered into on this 1st day of February in the year 1820 by and between Matilda
Barratt Polly Barratt and Mariah Barratt of the one part and Davis Wick of the other part such and all of
said Parties reside in the County of Southampton Virginia this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of four hundred and twenty dollars to have the said Barratts in hand paid by the said Davis
Wick the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged they the said Matilda Barratt Polly Barratt and Mariah
Barratt have jointly bargained and sold to him the said Davis Wick his heirs and assigns all the
right title interest and estate which we individually and jointly have in and to a certain tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton bounded by the lands of the following
named persons to wit, Thomas Newson on the East William Boycott on the South and Henry Kinnerd
on the West and North, it being the Land lately owned by Rhoda Barratt and supposed to contain Ninety Eight
acres of Land to the same more or less to him the said Davis Wick his heirs and assigns forever, notwithstanding
passing to ourselves jointly the quiet possession of two acres of said Land during each and all our natural
lives also a sufficiency of wood for one Chimney constantly to burn of wood require during the term of
their natural lives by furthermore said wood to be taken from the said Land their sold at any part
thereof where they the said Barratts may chose to take it and be the said Davis Wick To have and
to hold all other encumbrances to the said Land belonging except those above named free from the claim
of the said Matilda Barratt Polly Barratt and Mariah Barratt or either of them or either of their heirs
Executors or administrators and also free from the claim of all and every person and persons whomsoever
by us or hereby warranted and forever hereafter defend the right and title aforesaid to him the said
Davis Wick his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof we and each of us have hereunto set our hands
and affixed our seals the day and year first herein above written as

the County of Southampton & State of Virginia. This Indenture witnesseth that whereas the said J J Griffin is jointly
indebted to the above named Jacob Barnes in the sum of Eighty dollars which will appear as well by bond as
this Indenture and of even date herewith which sum of money is now and owing to the said Jacob Barnes and whereas
the said J J Griffin is willing to secure the punctual payment of the said sum of eighty dollars together with
the interest which shall accrue thereon Now therefore the said J J Griffin has for and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said William D Blanks at the executing and delivery of
these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and proved which the said W D Blanks his
heirs executors and assigns are forever released exonerated and discharged by the said J J Griffin has bargained
and sold and doth hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said W D Blanks the following named property to wit
