This Indenture made this 10th day of Nov. in the year of our Lord 1839 between Samuel L^e Robertson of Southampton City and state of N^o the debtor of the first part, Joseph G Holland of Isle of Wight (the trustee) of the second part, and John M Holland of Warrington County and state of N^o the creditor of the third part whereas the said Robertson is justly indebted to the said John M Holland in the sum of four hundred 75^{cts} to be paid on the 20th day of Dec. in the year first above mentioned as by bond bearing date the 10th day of November 1839 more fully appears which debt with the legal interest thereon according the said L^e Samuel L^e Robertson is willing and deserves to pay. Now this Indenture Witnesseth That for and in consideration of the prospect and also for the further considerations of One dollar to the said L^e Samuel L^e Robertson (the debtor) in hand paid by the said Joseph G Holland (the trustee) at and before the passing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robertson hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm to the said Joseph G Holland his heirs and assigns forever One boy named Miles & one girl named Melthy and her future increase and all the right title and interest of the said L^e Samuel L^e Robertson in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted slaves to have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted slaves and the future increase of the females thereof and all the other personal property hereby conveyed is unto the said Joseph G Holland his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever to the only proper use and benefit of the said Joseph G Holland his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever. And the said L^e C Robertson for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Joseph G Holland his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say that the said L^e Samuel L^e Robertson his heirs executors administrators the aforesaid slaves and the future increase of the females thereof and all the personal property hereby conveyed unto the said Joseph G Holland & his heirs executors administrators and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents upon trust notwithstanding that the said Joseph G Holland & his heirs executors and administrators shall permit the said L^e Samuel L^e Robertson to remain in quiet and peaceful possession of the said slaves and other personal property hereby conveyed and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of Four hundred dollars 75^{cts} either in whole or in part and then upon this further trust that they or any two or either of them or the survivors of them or the heirs executors administrators or assigns of such survivor shall and will soon after the happening of such default of payment as they or either of them may think proper or the said John M Holland his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall request sell the said slaves and the future increase of the females thereof and all the other personal property hereby conveyed to such part of the hereby granted as the Trustee or his representatives hereby authorized to act shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think to sell to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction after having provided the time and place of sale at their own discretion and given ten days notice thereof and also notifying the same by advertisement to be set up at the door of the Court House of the aforesaid County on some Court day previous to the day of sale and out of the money arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charges attending such sale pay to the said John M Holland his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the sum of Four hundred dollars 75^{cts} with the interest thereon accrued and the balance if any shall pay to the said L^e C Robertson his heirs or assigns
