This Indenture made this 17th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ Eighteen hundred and thirty nine. Between Abington Gardner and Margaret his wife (late Margaret Barnett) of the one part and William H Griffin of the other part all of the County of Southampton & parish of Abingway. Witnesseth that the said Abington Gardner & Margaret his wife in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Twenty five dollars of current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said William H Griffin at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said William H Griffin his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and known by the name of Parsley Barrell tract of Land or a part thereof containing by estimation One hundred and fourteen acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth. Beginning at a post Oak on the side of the road a corner of Eveline Ballards land thence a line of marked trees along the said Ballards land to a red Oak a Crop a small branch a corner of said Ballard & William H Atkinson land thence said Atkinson line to the run of black Creek thence the various courses of the Run of said Creek to Matthew Joiners do^d Land thence a line of marked trees of Joiners land to a post Oak on the south side of the main Road thence a straight line to a sweet gourd a corner of the said Wm H Griffin's land and thence road to the beginning. Together with all and singular the houses out houses offices buildings yards gardens woods ways lanes and water courses profits emoluments commodities advantages incidentments and appurtenances whatever to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or appertaining or known as a part or parcel thereof and the reversion or reversions remainder or remanente ipso et yearly rents thereof with every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the incidentments and appurtenances and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said William H Griffin his heirs and assigns forever & And the said Abington Gardner and Margaret his wife (late Barnett) or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
