 Southampton containing by estimation Eighty acres to the same more or less and bounded in the
 following manner. West by the lands of Benjamin Hart and the North by Seacock Swamp and
 the South and the lands of Benj L Drew on the East. To have and to hold the same land to the
 said Benjamin L Drew his heirs and assigns forever. Wee and each of us doth covenant to and
 with the said Benjamin L Drew that we are lawfully seized of the said Lands, have good
 right to convey it, and that the same is unencumbered. We do further covenant and bind ourselves
 our heirs and representatives to warrant and forever defend the title to the said Land and
 every part thereof to the said Benjamin L Drew his heirs and assigns against the lawful
