THIS Indenture made this 30th day of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty nine between Henry Soyner of the one part and Henry Kinross of the other part both of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Henry Soyner for and in consideration of twelve hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Henry Kinross the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Henry Kinross his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract of Land with a grist mill and all its appurtenances thereon belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton and state of Virginia and bounded as follows by the survey of George Williams Sumner Taylors deed Book 10 of Buchanan and Mather & Pote by estimation one hundred twenty one and a half acres more or less. To have and to hold all and singular the said granted land mill premises & appurtenances as before mentioned unto the said Henry Kinross his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Soyner for himself his heirs and assigns doth further agree to and with the said Henry Kinross his heirs &c that he will forever warrant and defend the right title and interest of the said Kinross &c before mentioned unto him the said Henry Kinross his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and demand of him the said Henry Soyner his heirs and assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming from or under him. THIS Indenture made and entered into on this 12th day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty by and between Jacob Burnes of Stafford County and state of North Carolina of the one part and Grover Hill of the County of Southampton Virginia of the other part This Indenture Witnesseth that whereas the said named Grover Hill has by a deed in writing bearing date the 13th day of September 1833 bargain and sold unto the above named Jacob Burnes in trust a certain lot or parcel of Land as will appear by said deed which deed is of record in the Clerk's office for the said County of Southampton and for purpose thereof named To wit the securing a sum of money due to Nicholas Barr Hill now the said Jacob Burnes has confirmed unto him full satisfaction of the extinguishment of said debt &c do hereby bargain sell convey and confirm unto him the said Grover Hill all the right title interest and estate which was conveyed to him the said Jacob Burnes in trust by the aforesaid deed and doth hereby warrant and defend the title hereunto to the said Grover Hill his heirs and assigns against himself his heirs and assigns.
