This Indenture made this 30th day of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty nine between Henry Joyner of the one part and Henry Rindred of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Henry Joyner for and in consideration of twelve hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Henry Rindred the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted sold and alienated and confirmed unto these presents do grant bargains and sell alien and confirm unto the said Henry Rindred his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract of Land with a grist Mill and all its appurtenances thereon belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows by the lands of George Williams James Taylors and Nathaniel D. Burham and Martha S. Poole by estimation one hundred twenty one and a half acres more or less To have and to hold all and singular the said granted land Mill premises & appurtenances as before mentioned unto the said Henry Rindred his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Joyner for himself his heirs and assigns with further agrees to and with the said Henry Rindred his heirs &c that he will give warrant and defend the right title and interest of the said lands &c before mentioned unto the said Henry Rindred his heirs and assigns forever against the claims and demands of him the said Henry Joyner his heirs and assigns or any other persons or persons whatsoever claiming from or under him. This Indenture made and entered into on this 12th day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and Forty by and between Jacob Burnes of Halifax County and state of North Carolina of the one part and George Hill of the County of Southampton Virginia of the other part This Indenture witnesseth that whereas the aforesaid George Hill has by a deed in writing bearing date the 13th day of September 1831 bargained and sold to the above named Jacob Burnes in trust a certain lot or parcel of Land as will appear by said deed which deed is on record in the Clerks office for the said County of Southampton and for purpose thereof named To wit the securing a sum of money due to Nicholas Burne Esq now the said Jacob Burnes trustee as aforesaid full satisfaction of the extinguishment of said debt &c do hereby bargain sell release and confirm unto him the said George Hill all the right title interest and estate which was conveyed to him the said Jacob Burnes in trust by the aforesaid deed and doth hereby warrant and defend the title hereby granted to the said George Hill his heirs and assigns against himself his heirs and assigns.
