To wit. the said Allen Hill Henry Hill and Alexander Alsop and supposed to contain Fifty one acres of Land thereunto with whither more or less. To have and to hold the said parcel or lot of land and every part and parcel thereof with all the right title interest and estate to the said Land belonging to him the said Allen Hill his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of him the said Green Hill his heirs and assigns also free from the claim of all and every person or persons whomsoever with and as by these presents warrant and defined the title conveyed as aforesaid to him the said Allen Hill his heirs and assigns forever.
