This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty between  
John L Cocke and Patience about his wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and William  
Holt of the said County and State of the other part. Whereas it is agreed between the said John L Cocke and Patience his wife  
in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred dollars to be paid by the said William Holt at the  
insuring and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained and sold  
and by these presents so bargained and sold unto the said William Holt his heirs and assigns a certain tract of  
land lying in the County of Southampton containing one hundred and thirteen  $\frac{1}{3}$  acres more or less  
and bounded by Barrows Road on the North Bangs Edwards's land on the west Mill Pops on the  
South and Wm. Nicholson on the East together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging  
in any way appertaining. To have and to hold the the said tract of Land with all and singular other  
the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel  
thereof and their appurtenances unto the said William Holt his heirs and assigns forever. And the  
said John L Cocke and Patience about his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of  
Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William  
Holt his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said John L Cocke and Patience
