This Indenture made this 20th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty Between Anselm Denson and Mary Ann his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Robertson Holt of the same County of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Anselm Denson and Mary Ann his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty two dollars as is before the enrolling and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Robertson Holt his heirs executors administrators or assigns a tract of Land known as the Anthony Andrews tract lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation Fifty acres more or less and bounded in the following manner by the lands of Hawkins Bonds on the North, Hepher Andrews on the East, and Robertson Holt on the South and West. To have and to hold the said Land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Robertson Holt his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Anselm Denson and Mary Ann his wife doth covenant and agree to with the said Robertson Holt that they will forever warrant and defend the right and title in and to the said tract of Land to the said Robertson Holt his heirs and assigns against the claims or demand of all and every person whatsoever. In Testimony whereof the said Anselm Denson and Mary Ann his wife hath hereunto set their hands and seals this day above mentioned.
