This Indenture made and entered into on this 22^d day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Forty Between Benjamin Story and Elizabeth Story his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one Part, and Polly Story of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Story and Elizabeth his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars Current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Polly Story at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted Bargains sold aliened unfeoffed and confirmed unto the said Polly Story her heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke containing by a late Survey Ninety One Acres to the sum more or less, it being one half of the tract or parcel of Land that was bequeathed to the said Benjamin Story and Lunsell Story son by their Father Samuel Story deceased in his last will and Testament and bounded as follows: West Beginning at a pine standing in Samm Story s line a new corner for said Benjamin and Polly Story thence along said Samm Story s line N 57 1/2° W 25 poles to a hickory thence N 31 1/2° E 11 1/2 poles to a pine corner for said Polly Story s Hancock land thence along her N 31 1/2° E 11 1/2 poles to a pine thence N 21 1/2° E 59 poles to a black gum standing at the end of the Dick Swamp thence down the run of said swamp to a pine Rockville corner thence along Rockville line S 23 1/2° E 71 poles to a lightwood stump thence S 32 1/2° W 38 poles to a dead pine there I 30° W 22 poles to a large pine a corner for Burnell
