This Indenture made this 24th day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty
nine between John Drake and Caroline S his wife of the one part, and F. S. Mahone of the other
part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said John Drake and Caroline
S his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars Lawful money of Virginia to them
in hand paid by the said F. S. Mahone in or before the sealing and delivery of these presents to the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell and convey unto the said F. S. Mahone his heirs and assigns forever the following described parcel
of Land (viz) the one fourth part of an undivided tract or parcel of land which Martha Drake deceased
deceased seized and possessed of it being the same tract or parcel of land which was allotted to the before mentioned
Martha Drake dec'd in the division of her dec'd Father's land Jeremiah Drake about the year 1826 as
may be seen by reference to the Commissioners Report in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Va
and containing by estimation about ninety six acres more or less. To have and to hold the said tract
or parcels of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said F. S. Mahone his heirs
and assigns forever: to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said F. S. Mahone his heirs
and assigns forever; and the said John Drake and Caroline S his wife for themselves their heirs execs
and assigns by these presents forever hereafter warrant and defend the right and title of said land
to him the said F. S. Mahone his heirs and assigns against the claims or demands of all and every per-
son or persons whatsoever: In Witness whereof the said John Drake & Caroline S his wife had hereunto
