To have and to hold the same to him the said Thomas Symon and his heirs forever; and the said Polly Drake for herself her heirs executors administrators or assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Thomas Symon his heirs and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and defend all rights title claims or demands of any person or persons claiming or demanding the said Land being part or parcel thereof. To have and to hold free from the claim or claims of him the said John Bennett his heirs and of every other person or persons claiming by through or under him.
