And the said James Vick and Delilah his wife for themselves and their heirs the one hundred and thirteen acres of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Patrick Rowe his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said James Vick and Delilah his wife or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons who served shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents, In witness whereof the said James Vick and Delilah his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.

This Indenture made this 26th day February 1839 between Irenia Cobb widow dec'd and John Donegore dec'd and as Commissioner appointed by the County Court of Southampton under this date 1st February term 1839 to sell the undivided land of which Mary B Donegore widow and sister of John Donegore dec'd seized and sold Irenia Cobb all of the County of Southampton of the other part being the said John Donegore and late of the aforesaid County by his last will and Testament bequeathed to his wife Mary B Donegore said the lands and tenements which he owned and possessed during his life at his death direct his executors to sell the whole tract and divide the proceeds equally between his children and whomever one third part of the said sum was the undivided land of his wife Mary B Donegore, and to effect a legal sale of the whole of the whole tract a decree of the County Court was obtained as before stated, and whomever the said Irenia Cobb about 1st and Court having given
