This Indenture made and entered into this fourteenth day of March Eighteen hundred and forty between William Parker and Susan his wife of the County of Suffolk of the first part and George A W Newsom of the County of Southampton of the second part: Witnesseth that the said William Parker and Susan his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Thirty dollars to them in hand paid or to be paid by the said George A W Newsom the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted his quire and sold and by these presents do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said George A W Newsom all our interest right and title in the several parts of other Nicholson which was allotted to the said Ann Nicholson as her share in the Lands of her late husband Richd Nicholson deceased which land the said Richd Nicholson resided at the time of his death lying and being in the County of Southampton with all its appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Geo A W Newsom his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold the said premises above mentioned to the said Geo A W Newsom his heirs and assigns to the sole use and benefit of the said Geo A W Newsom his heirs and assigns forever: And the said William Parker and Susan his wife for themselves their heirs executors & administrators will forever warrant and defend the said Geo A W Newsom whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year first above mentioned as
