and Convey to Robert Proctor and his heirs for the consideration of Three hundred dollars to us paid a large
or Lot of Land in the state of Virginia and County of Southampton containing by estimation one acre
or thereabouts more or less and bounded by the land belonging to the heirs of Majr Genl Bailey decd and Thomas
Athens and lying immediately on the Proctor Road and known by the name of Barley Store. To have
and to hold the same to the said Robert Proctor his heirs and assigns forever: we do Covenant to the said
Robert Proctor that we are lawfully seized of the said Land have a good right to Convey it, & that the
same is unincumbered: we do further Covenant and bind ourselves our heirs & representatives to warrant
& forever defend the title to the said Land and every part thereof to the said Robert Proctor his
heirs & assigns against the lawful Claims of all persons whatsoever. In Witness our hands
