Mahone admr. of Martha Drake dec'd of the third part. Whereas the said John Drake on the 28th day of Decr in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two in order to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to the said Martha Drake dec'd by Indenture of trust of that date Convey to the said Geth H. Bishop his heirs executors &c the following property to wit all his the said John Drakes right title and interest in the Land there owned and occupied by Mary Drake widow of Jeremiah Drake dec'd as her exec. right which was laid off and assigned to her by Commr appointed by the County Court of Gloucester together with its several enclosures buildings and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land appertaining or belonging upon trust for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned; And whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust the said John Drake hath fully satisfied and paid to the said F. J. Mahone admr. of the said Martha Drake dec'd the sum of money hereby secured which the said F. J. Mahone doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for the Considerations aforesaid as well as for the further Consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said John Drake to the said Geth H. Bishop at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Geth H. Bishop with the intent and approbation of the said F. J. Mahone admr. of the said Martha Drake dec'd signified by his being a party to these presents and the said F. J. Mahone admr. of the said Martha Drake dec'd have granted bargained and sold remised released and confirmed; and by these presents do grant bargains and sell remise release & confirm, unto the said John Drake all the estate right title interest claim & demands both at Law and in equity, which the said Geth H. Bishop and F. J. Mahone admr. of the said Martha Drake dec'd have or hold in the Land above described To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of Land to the said John Drake his heirs executors and assigns forever. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Drake his heirs executors and assigns forever. And the said Geth H. Bishop and F. J. Mahone admr. of the said Martha Drake dec'd furthermore their heirs executors and adms. the above mentioned Land unto the said John Drake his heirs executors and assigns in as full and ample manner as the sum was warranted by the said John Drake by the deed of trust above recited do warrant the same to the said John Drake against the claims or demands of whom so ever Geth H. Bishop and F. J. Mahone admr. of the said Martha Drake dec'd and all persons claiming by or under them or either of them.
