This Indenture made and executed this 16th day of March A D one thousand eight hundred and Forty
between Solomon Johnson of the first part, Jethro Cobb of the second part and Lemuel R Gardner of the third
part all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Solomon Johnson hath for and in
consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Lemuel R Gardner the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged bargained and sold alienated and confirmed and doth by these presents bargain and sell
alienate and confirm unto the said Lem R Gardner his executors assigns and assigns forever, all the said
Solomon Johnson's reversion and interest in his Mother Elizabeth Johnson's estate both real and personal
also all the said Solomon Johnson's stock hogs Horses farming Minerals and household and kitchen furniture
Upon the following trust and condition, Viz. The said Solomon Johnson stands jointly indebted to the said
Jethro Cobb in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars which appears by note bearing date with these
presents with interest from date and on demand this day. Now if the said Solomon Johnson shall
fail to pay the aforesaid debt with interest when and on demand it shall then be lawful and right for
the said Lem R Gardner as soon as requested by the said Jethro Cobb after having given sufficient
Notice of the time and place of sale to sell at public auction the aforesaid reversion and interest and
the aforesaid property to the highest bidder for Cash and out of the money thus raised to pay all the
pertaining these presents; and the aforesaid debt and interest, and the surplus of any pay due to
the said Solomon Johnson or order: In Testimony whereof we the parties have hereunto set hands

This Indenture made this 5th day of February one thousand eight hundred and Forty between Wiley D
Delk Benjamin Swettney and attorney W his wife of Isle of Wight County of one part, and Joseph Proctor
of Surry County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Wiley D Delk Benjamin Swettney and attorney
W his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and fifty seven dollars and
fourteen Cents to them in hand paid or otherwise secured by the said Joseph Proctor at or before the
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain
and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alienate confirm and confirm to the
said Joseph Proctor and to his heirs and assigns forever all their interest (except one acre lying
about two hundred yards nearly due west of the Dwelling house known as a grass ground) in
certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation three hundred
and fifty seven acres be the same more or less it being the land on which Josiah D Delk at present
resides including the tract called Warrens and bounded on the East by the main road of Blacks water and the said
North by the lands of Nathaniel Greenhaw, Henry W Hollmann and Arthur Hollmann, and the said
South west by Tarquin Swamp to the mouth of the deep branch up said branch to the main Road
and down said Road to the main road of Blacks water together with all trees woods underwood both
Commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging
or in any wise appertaining and also the reversion and reversionary common and common
rights and services of the said premises and every part thereof (except their interest in the one
above excepted) and all the estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of them the
