This Indenture made this 5th day of February then thousand eight hundred and Forty between Isaac M DeLk Wiley I DeLk Benjamin Swatney and Martha W his wife of the one part and Wilson Jones of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isaac M DeLk Wiley I DeLk Benjamin Swatney and Martha W his wife for and in consideration of one hundred and sixty eight dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid or otherwise secured by the said Wilson Jones at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeof and confirm to the said Wilson Jones and to his heirs and assigns forever all their intent in a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and eleven acres be the same more or less and bounded on the East by the main Run of Black water on the South by Mill (or Susapin) Swamp on the west by the deep branch and on the North by the main Road and Potters Bridge to the main run of Blackwater together with all trees woods remainder Commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the revenues and reversion remainder and remainder rights and titles of the said premises and every part thereof and all the estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of them the said Isaac M DeLk Wiley I DeLk Benjamin Swatney and Martha W his wife or their heirs and or to the said premises or any part thereof. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Wilson Jones his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Isaac M DeLk Wiley I DeLk Benjamin Swatney and Martha W his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Wilson Jones his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Isaac M DeLk Wiley I DeLk Benjamin Swatney and Martha W his wife or either of them or their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do
