as his said wife the use and occupation of the above mentioned tract of Land and premises during their lives)
and after the death of them the said Land is to go to the before named Children of the said John Drake
or the survivor or survivors of them if either one or more of them should die without a lawful heir of
their body and in case of the death of all the said Children without a lawful heir of their body
then at their death or at the death of the said Byrd Sumner & Nancy his wife the before mentioned
tract of Land and premises is hereby granted to Catherine the wife of the said John Drake or of
she be dead to her then living Children if any she have at the time - And the said Byrd
Sumner hereby warrants & defends the right and title of the before mentioned tract of Land
and premises as before conveyed against himself and every other person whatsoever. In testimony

This Indenture made this 15th of November 1838 between James Jenkins and wife Elizabeth of the one part
and John Vick of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Va. Witness that the
said James Jenkins and wife in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars lawful money of
Va. to them for hand paid by the said John Vick at or before the making and delivery of these
premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by these premises
do bargain and sell unto the said John Vick his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of
Land with the appurtenances situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of
Nettaway it being the tract whereon James Jenkins formerly lived and bounded as follows to wit
on the south by William Davis's land on the East by John Vick's land formerly Jenkins land
on the North and West by the land of James Bottom now Wm Davis containing by a survey
division and 2/3 acres be the same more or less I convey unto the said John Vick and his heirs
for ever all us belonging to the same or any part thereof. To have the said tract of Land with the
premises before mentioned and all and singular the premises hereby mentioned and the said
to be bargained and sold unto the said John Vick his heirs and assigns forever and the said
James Jenkins and wife released for themselves and their heirs do warrant and defend
