This Indenture made and entered into this the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year 1840 between Theodore Troyant of the one part and Spratley L Williams of the other parts both of the County of Southampton. Whereas the said Theodore Troyant is fully indebted unto books of Brother Merchants of the Town of Portsmouth vs in the sum of two thousand One hundred dollars or thereabouts, to Ann Eliza Fitzhugh of the County of Southampton in the sum of One hundred and Twenty dollars, to David Griffith of the Town of Portsmouth vs in the sum of two hundred dollars or thereabouts, to James Murchison of the State of Tennessee in the sum of two hundred dollars or thereabouts, the payment of which said debt the said Troyant honestly desires to secure — and whereas there is an unsettled account between the said Theodore Troyant and Thomas G Peake aforesaid. John G Peake aforesaid growing out of the transactions between the said Troyant and the said Peake in the lifetime of the said Peake. And if upon a settlement a balance is found due the said Peake estate from the said Troyant, the said Troyant honestly desires to secure the payment of such balance whatever it may be. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Theodore Troyant in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him now handed paid by the said Spratley L Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and Conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and Convey unto the said Spratley L Williams his Executors Administrators and assigns the said Troyant's entire stock of goods wares and merchandizes now or hereafter in his store or New Haven likewise One large flat, the said Troyant also transfers to the said Williams his executors & assigns the debts due him which are specified in the Schedule or inventory annexed to this deed. To have and to hold the said stock of goods, wares and merchandizes together with the aforesaid debts unto the said Spratley L Williams his executors & assigns forever. In trust nevertheless that he the said Spratley L Williams shall himself or by his agent if he deems it necessary to appoint one sell and dispose of the said stock of goods wares and merchandizes in such manner as to him shall seem right and shall have full power & authority to collect by suit or otherwise the debts aforesaid and out of the monies arising from the sales and collections aforesaid after deducting the necessary and usual expenses of this trust pay and satisfy the debts herein before mentioned and intended to be secured, if sufficient for that purpose if not then share and share alike and whatever balance may remain shall be restored to the said Troyant or his legal representative. And the said Spratley L Williams hereby promises that he will faithfully execute the trust herein imposed on him.
