Witnesseth that the said Martha Dandred for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar current money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid, by the said Lewis Worrell at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever all my right title interest claim or demand of or to the lands of Bennett Barnes do'd lying in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia which said right was devised to me by the last will & Testament of said Bennett Barnes &c. in case that his said Son Thomas Barnes should die without lawful issue now in case that I ever should be entitled to a right in the aforesaid Lands of Bennett Barnes &c. by his last will and Testament, I do hereby for my self my heirs Executors admors &c. Covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Worrell his heirs Executors admors and assigns that I will by these presents (for my self & every other person claiming under or by me) warrant and forever defende the right and title of the same and every part of the same unto him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever.
