This Indenture made this 1st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty between Arnd W Woodward of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Westa Pope of the said County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Arnd W Woodward for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said Westa Pope at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Westa Pope his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton it being my interest in the two thirds of the lands owned by Anthony Woodward which said two thirds of land was sold under a deed of trust by Augustus Pope acting as Trustee to said deed of trust for the benefit of Westa Pope containing by estimation sixteen and two third acres to the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Henry Joyner, William C Wilson Westa Pope and by the lands now in the possession of said Westa Pope as his wife's dower right in the lands of John Woodward also by the lands of Gumpson to Record. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land together with all the appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the privileges to and for the only proper use of him the said Westa Pope his heirs and assigns forever. all the interest and right that I the said Arnd W Woodward may have in the said tract or parcel of land I do warrant and forever defend unto him the said Westa Pope his heirs and assigns forever.
