Witnesseth that the said Mordecai Bradshaw and Amy his wife in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said John B. Munry at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof a true acknowledgement have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said John B. Munry his heirs and assigns one tract or parcel of land containing by estimation 133 acres be the same more or less lying in the North side of the road leading from Black Water Bridge to Vicks Old Tavern and bounded by the lands of Abridgeton Bradshaw, Willis Bradshaw Tolly Vick and Rich^d H. Branch together with all ways waters and water courses profits commodities revenues and reversions remainders and remnants and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said 133 acres of land with the Tenements and all and singular other premises herein before mentioned or contained to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said John B. Munry his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mordecai Bradshaw and Amy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said acres and thing there acres with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John B.
