This Indenture made and entered the nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred & thirty five between Jesse Parker son of the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia
and Edward R. Hunter & W^m M. Jones of the County of Nansemond and state aforesaid of the one part and
James I. Moore of the aforesaid County of Southampton & state aforesaid of the other parts whereas by a
deed of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for the County of Nansemond made and entered
the 16th day of May A.D. one thousand eight hundred & thirty five in a cause lately depending in the said
Court between Robert Porter & sons, Thoburn & Smith W^m J. Redwood, Hannon & Hare, Abner Birdick
and others against the heirs of Wiley W. Jenkins deceased, It was decreed and ordered that Jesse Parker
son of Edward R. Hunter, W^m M. Jones, & some one after giving thirty days notice of the time and
place of sale should expose to public auction upon a credit of twelve months the tract of Land of
which Wiley W. Jenkins died seized and possessed lying on Black Water River in Southampton County
in the State of Virg^a Called old South Long said to contain one hundred and fifty five acres including
the reversionary interest in the down Land allotted to Mary Jenkins widow and relict of the said
Wiley W. Jenkins dec^d; except so much as should be necessary to pay and discharge the proper and
necessary expenses of said suit and after deducting the same from the amount to take a bond for the
balance thereof with good security payable to themselves as by decree directed. And whereas in
pursuance of said decree the said Jesse Parker son of Edward R. Hunter & W^m M. Jones commissioners
as afores^d did on the 18th day of August A.D. 1835 on the premises expose to public sale to the
highest bidder the said tract or parcel of Land (including the reversionary interest in the down
Land allotted to the said Mary Jenkins) lying in Southampton County Called old South Long
containing as afores^d one hundred and fifty five acres more or less adjoining the lands of Jesse Parker
James Moore, Edward Jenkins and others, notice of the time and place of sale having been
given thirty days previous thereto in conformity to said decree when James I. Moore became the
highest bidder and purchased of the said tract or parcel of Land (subject to the claim of the
said Mary Jenkins) for the sum of Eleven hundred and one dollar and seventy six cents
and it was further decreed and ordered that the said commissioners who reported in the
case make to the purchaser deed without warranty: This Indenture therefore further
witnesseth that the said Jesse Parker son of Edward R. Hunter & W^m M. Jones commissioners as
