This Indenture made the 2<sup>d</sup> day of May in the year One thousand eight hundred and forty between James W Parker and Martha Ann his wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia the one part and Joseph H Parker of the County of Suffolk aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said James W Parker & Martha Ann his wife in Consideration of Four hundred & thirty five dollars of Lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Parker at or before the ensuing 1/8 delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain & sell unto the said Joseph H Parker his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Suffolk & Southampton the line dividing the boundaries professing thereby containing by a late Survey One hundred & forty five acres more or less bounded as follows Beginning at white Oak by the river of Spring Swamp corner for said Joseph H Parker thence due East N 71° 53' 32" poles to Willow Oak by Butler's Road in Charles Newsons line thence along said Road S 57° 23' 58" poles to S 80° 00' 00" in the land of the late Martha Clements thence N 87° 56' 61" 35 poles to Richard P Clements line thence his line N 36° 6' 10" poles N 31° 20' 2" poles N 31° 6' 86" poles N 32° 6' 34" poles N 37° 6' 8" poles N 34° 5' 8" 126 poles N 18° 6' 35" poles to Red Oak in Mary Newsons line thence her line N 45° 1/2' 6' 21" poles to small pine around S 37° 6' 35" poles to corner post Oak thence E 61° 6' 133" poles S 60° 6' 20" poles to red Oak corner for Glemont Parker thence his line N 3° W 160" poles to a small white Oak bush thence N 88° 6' 15" poles to the main road of said Spring Swamp thence up the main road to the beginning To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging with the boundaries hereinabove set all & singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights, members and appurtenances whatsoever the said Joseph H Parker his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only profit use and behoof of him the said Joseph H Parker his heirs and assigns forever and the said James W Parker & Martha Ann his wife for themselves & their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto mentioned unto the said Joseph H Parker his heirs & assigns free from the claims & demands of them the said James W Parker & Martha Ann his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs & assigns all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant to forego & forgo all & singular the claims & demands of them the said James W Parker & Martha Ann his wife
