Hart as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said John R. Hart at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John R. Hart his executors administrators and assigns all the tract or parcel of Land that I purchased of Mills Eley known as the Eley tract. To have and to hold the said land unto him the said John R. Hart his executors administrators and assigns forever and I do hereby Robert Hart for himself his executors administrators the said Land unto the said John R. Hart his executors administrators and assigns against the Claim of him the said Robert Hart his executors and administrators and against the Claim or Claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant and forever defend them by these presents. Stephenson and the Mother Sophia Lowe for a certain tract of Land which I have and interest in which money was paid before the executing and delivery of these presents which is hereby acknowledged, I the said John M. Lowe have bargained and sold and by these presents do
