This Indenture made this nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord on the one and eight hundred & forty between William D. Burley of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Edward Butts of the same County and State of the second part Witnesseth that the said Wm D. Burley for and in Consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward Butts and his heirs forever all my right title and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land whereof Henry Gurley died seized and possessed situated on flaggery run in Hampton County and Parish of Nottingham it being the tract of Land which the said Henry Gurley purchased of Mrs. Gains containing five hundred and forty five acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Mrs. White said Missings Mill Pond the lands of Jesse Drury and others of Sumner Scots. To have and to hold the aforesaid right title and interest in the said tract or parcel of Land together with the appurtenances to him the said Edward Butts and his heirs forever. And the said William D. Burley his heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid right title and interest in said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances to him the said Edward Butts his heirs and assigns forever shall and will lawfully and lawfully defend.
