This Indenture made this 15th day of May One thousand eight hundred & forty between John Waddell and Margaret H Waddell his wife of the County of Norfolk & State of North Carolina of the one part and John Wicks of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the second part. Witnesseth that the said John Waddell and Margaret H his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Wicks at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John Wicks his heirs and assigns all of his right title interest claimed or demanded in and to the land that formerly belonged to Joseph Wicks which was given to him by his Father Joseph Wicks deceased known as the Wicks Tavern tract & lately sold under a deed of Trust to James Wicks trustee for the benefit of John Wicks and John Waddell & bought by the said Wicks and Waddell at a trust sale made by said James Wicks trustee as will appear by his deed to them; Containing almost three hundred acres more or less and bounded by the lands of — To have and to hold the said whole right title interest & claims in said land with the Tenements hereditaments and all and singular the franchises thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto; unto him the said John Wicks his heirs and assigns forever. And the said John Waddell and Margaret H his wife for themselves their heirs (and for no other person whomsoever) the said right title interest and claims with all and singular the premises & appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Wicks his heirs and assigns forever from the claims or claims of them the said John Waddell and Margaret H his wife & their heirs (but not against the claims of any other person whomsoever) shall and will warrant and defend by these presents such title and such title only in the aforesaid lands and premises as have been heretofore conveyed by the said James Wicks trustee as aforesaid to the said John Waddell. In Testimony whereof the said John Waddell and Margaret H have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
