This Indenture made and entered into on this 29th day of May in the year of our Lord 1837 by and between Reubin Whitfield of the one part and Benjamin Burned of the other part each of whom reside in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia. This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Reubin Whitfield have for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Burned at and before the executing and delivery of these presents have bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Benjamin Burned his heirs and assigns a certain Lot of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing three acres of Land it being the Land which the said Whitfield purchased of Benjamin Jordan some ten or Twenty years since as is supposed the boundary of which is best known by referring to the deed from said Jordan to said Whitfield which is of record in the Clerk's office of said County. So have and do hold the said three acres of Land and every part thereof with all the right title interest and estate which in the said Reubin Whitfield has next before this conveyance had and held in and to the same to him the said Benjamin Burned his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or demand of him the said Reubin Whitfield his heirs or assigns hereby warranting and defending the uninterrupted enjoyment and benefits arising from the said Land to him the said Benjamin Burned his heirs and assigns forever against himself his heirs and assigns and also against any and every person and persons whomsoever, For Witness whereof in the said Reubin Whitfield have hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year herein first before written -
