Lawrence his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty three hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Allen Edwards at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John B. Lawrence and Amanda L. Lawrence his wife hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain grant sell and convey unto Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns One Certain tract or parcel of Land lying and situate in the County of Southampton containing by estimation Eight hundred and eight acres be the same more or less, and bounded as follows (Viz) on the South East and South by the old road running from black water bridge between William Lawrence's Still Land & Nathan Lutens and to Joseph Johnson on the South West and West by the lands of Joseph Johnson Nathan Lutens Old place, Giles Johnson, Jesse Johnson, Sumner and William Stephenson North West and North by the land of William Stephenson to Sea Cock and thence down to Black water and down Black water to the bridge again - which said tract or parcel of land the said John B. Lawrence and Amanda L. Lawrence his wife purchased of William Lawrence together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances unto the said Allen Edwards his heirs or assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Allen Edwards his heirs or assigns forever and the said John B. Lawrence and Amanda L. Lawrence his wife covenants promises and agrees to warrant and defend the appurtenances thereto the said Allen Edwards his heirs or assigns and against the claim and demand of the said John B.
