of the County of Montgomery and state of Ohio of the one part, and Mason Hill late of the County of
Southampton in the state of Virginia of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Hill has for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and seven dollars and twenty five Cents to him in hand paid by the
said Mason Hill hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the
said Mason Hill executors as aforesaid that interest in Ten acres of Land which is specified named and
bequeathed in the last will and Testament of Amey Hill dec^d in a certain proviso that in to say of
Hill made to the said William Hill's sister Elizabeth during her natural life, and at her death to
the heirs of the said Elizabeth and the said Benjamin Hill being her only heir to the said Ten acres of
land lying and being in the County of Southampton and a part of the lands of which the above named
William Hill dec^d seized and possessed and that which now belongs to the legatees of the said William
Hill: To have and to hold the said interest under the will of the said Amey Hill, dec^d and the right
title which have accrued from and by said Hill to him the said Benjamin Hill he them the
said Mason Hill and others legatees of the said William Hill dec^d to them said Legatees and their
heirs and assigns forever: free from the claim of him the said Benjamin Hill his heirs and
