This Indenture made this 22nd day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and Forty between John B Lawrence and Amund his wife & William Lawrence of the first part of
County of Isle of white & State of Virginia and William Brett of the County of Southampton and
State. Witness that the said John B Lawrence and Amund & William Lawrence for and in consideration
of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars good and Lawful money of Virginia to them in hand
paid by the said William Brett at & before the concluding and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth
give grant bargain and sell unto the said William Brett his heirs and assigns forever one certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and state of Virginia
Containing fifty two acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows on the South by
William Lawrence Grumples place and of Jordan Sperry on the West by Jordan Sperry on the
North by Jordan Sperry & on the East by Anton Britt & Jordan Sperry. Together with all &
singular appurtenances whatsoever to the said belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the
Leisure and recreations, remunerations and remainders and of every part and parcel thereof. To
have and to hold the said land with with the Tenements hereditaments and all and singular
other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be hereby granted bargained & sold
and every part and parcel thereof with every appurtenant rights members and appurtenances
unto the said William Brett his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John B Lawrence Amund
Lawrence his wife & William Lawrence for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular
the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Brett his heirs and
assigns forever free from the claim or claims of them the said John B Lawrence Amund Lawrence
his wife & William Lawrence or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every
person or persons whatsoever shall will will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness

hundred and fifty four dollars to him in hand paid by the said Solomon D Parker the receipt whereof the
said Joseph H Parker and Susan J Parker his wife with hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and
sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Solomon D Parker one certain tract or
parcel of Land lying and being in the Counties of Suffolk and Southampton aforesaid containing one
hundred and eighteen acres be the same more or less and bounded by the Lands of Gray Barker's estate
Rich D Clements estate Wiley H Morris and Joseph H Parker. To have and to hold the said
