This Indenture made and entered into on this 18th day of March in the year of our Lord
 eighteen hundred and Forty, Between John Drake and Caroline Drake his wife of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and John E. Beale of the same County
 and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said John Drake and Caroline his wife for
 and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars current money of the Commonwealth of
 Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John E. Beale at or before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargain sold aliened
 enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien
 enfeoff and confirm unto the said John E. Beale his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or
 parcel of land (situate) lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke
 containing by survey One hundred and fifty one and half acres (be the same more or less) it being
 the several land of Mary Drake wid. widow of Jeremiah Drake s. i. d. (The grave yard excepted,
 also the rights of Miss Drake's children in said tract of land should they be legally entitled
 to any part thereof) and bounded altogether by the lands of said John E. Beale for further par-
 ticulars respecting the boundaries; reference may be had to the Commissioners Report
 in the Clerk's office of this County on the divisions of the lands of Jeremiah Drake s. i. d. To have
 and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all its appurtenances shoul-
 ding or in any wise appertaining unto him the said John E. Beale his heirs and assigns forever
 (except as above excepted) to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John E. Beale his
 heirs and assigns forever and the said John Drake and Caroline his wife for themselves their heirs
 &c. and each of them with hereby covenant and agree to and for the said John E. Beale his heirs executors ad-
 executors admors and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all
 the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or
 parcel thereof (except as above excepted) against themselves their heirs and all and every other
 person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said John Drake and Caroline Drake have here-
