This Indenture made the Eighth day of June in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred  
and forty Between William Harris Patrick Rowe and Matthew Wells Commissioners upon  
by the Court for the purpose of the one part and William Turner of the other part. Witnesseth  
the said William Harris Patrick Rowe and Matthew Wells Commissioners in consideration  
of forty five dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said William  
Turner at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargains and sell unto  
the said William Turner two hours and eighty a certain tract or parcel of Land Containing  
thirty five acres to the same more or less and bounded Viz, beginning at a corner tree a  
Spanish oak standing in Matthew Wells and William Harris line thence a straight line  
of Spanish oak between the said land and William Harris to the Cypress Swamp to a  
corner tree a black Gum standing in the said swamp Between the said land William Harris  
and Jep Lankford thence up the swamp between the said lands and Jep Lankford to  
the mouth of a small branch thence up the said branch Between the said land and  
Matthew Wells to the beginning together with all the singular houses dove houses barns  
buildings stables yards gardens orchards lands tenements meadows pasture feeding commons  
woods underwoods ways water water courses fishing privileges profits easements communitie  
unvantage emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land  
belonging or appertaining or the same used or enjoyed or accepted reputed taken or known
