gains and sell unto the said James Blythe his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and containing by estimation sixty acres
more or less and bounded as follows (to west) beginning at a white Oak on the side of the road in
the edge of the Horse Pen Branch thence down said Branch to the corner of Ditching and Butrell
in Hog Run thence up said run to the Cypress bridge Roads thence down said road to the beginning
To have and to hold the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto
belonging unto him the said James Blythe his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas C Jones
and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns with covenant
promise and agree to and with the said James Blythe his heirs and assigns forever and in said
Thomas C Jones and Martha his wife will by these presents warrant and defend the right and title
to the said tract of land to the said James Blythe his heirs and assigns forever; And witness whereof the
said Thomas C Jones and Martha his wife both hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the
day and year first above written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of January 1830 between James
Blythe of the first part Littleton R Edwards of the second part and Thomas C Jones of the third part of the County
of Southampton. Witnesseth that the said James Blythe being justly indebted unto the said Thomas C Jones in the
following sum of money that is to say in the sum of Eighty seven dollars and fifty cents due the first day of
January 1830 and carrying interest from the first day of January 1830 and the further sum of eighty seven dollars
and fifty cents due the first day of January 1832 to carry interest from the first day of January 1830 and one
for the sum of Sixty dollars carrying interest from the 1st day of March 1830 as will fully appear by three
several bonds bearing even date with these presents and the said James Blythe being desirous of paying
the payment of the said several sums of money to the said Thomas C Jones he the said to carry to
the said Littleton R Edwards the property herein after mentioned and trust to be sold for that purpose
Now therefore this Indenture further witnesseth that the said James Blythe for and in consideration
of the premises aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand
paid by the said Littleton R Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
and sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Littleton
R Edwards his heirs executors administrators and assigns the following property to wit One tract
Horse one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and containing
sixty acres more or less being the same tract of land which the said Blythe purchased of the said
Simeon C Jones by deed dated the 1st day of January 1820. To have and to hold the property aforesaid
unto him the said Littleton R Edwards his heirs executors administrators and assigns to the only purpose and intent
of him the said Edwards his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever. Upon the following tract and infor-
mances; Neverthless that if the said James Blythe shall fail to pay and discharge the aforesaid debts
to the said Thomas C Jones as they respectively become due it shall and may be lawful for
the said Littleton R Edwards or in case of his death for his legal personal representative who is
hereby authorized to act to make sale of the property aforesaid or so much thereof as shall be
sufficient for the purpose for cash being required by the said Jones his executors administrators and assigns
so to do and having given reasonable public notice of the time and place of sale and of the
monies arising from such sale shall after satisfying the cost and expenses of said sale and
this conveyance pay to the said Thomas C Jones his executors administrators and assigns the amount so paid
at the time and the balance if any pay over to the said James Blythe at his legal personal
