 in consideration of the sum of six hundred and fifteen dollars the receipt is hereby fully
 acknowledged the said William B Goodwyn and Eliza his wife have bargained and sold
 and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto Samuel Drury his heirs and assigns
 forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County and the District
 of the three Creeks containing two hundred and five acres to be the same once or less
 and bounded as follows, beginning at a horn bound at A on the three Creeks corner made
 corner to W^m B Goodwyn thence along his line nearly chopped S 25° W 108 poles to a second
 gund S 80° W 12 poles to a beach S 16° W 62 poles S 15° W 60 poles to a white oak N 67° W 26 poles
 to a pine a corner to Samuel Drury along his line N 2° E 122 poles to the meadow round the
 said meadow as it meanders to a run of the three Creeks N 2° W 24 poles to the main
 run of the three Creeks and round the said Creek as it meanders to the Beginning together
 with all the appurtenances and benefits thereunto belonging: To have and to hold the
