This Indenture made this 22 day of July 1840 between Elizabeth Woodard of the

 Whereas Elizabeth Woodard executed a bond to Jesse B. Woodard son of Edward Woodard dec'd
 for the sum of Twenty five dollars and 60 cts that being the amt of her purchase at the sale of
 Edward Woodard her husband which is payable at the expiration of the credit of said sale which
 bond the said John M Gurley become security to and the said Elizabeth Woodard being desirous
 to secure the said John M Gurley himself as her security. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that
 for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful
 money of Virginia to the said Elizabeth Woodard in hand paid by the said Mills A Brice at
 and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is being admitted
 the said Eliz: Woodard hath given granted bargain and sold unto the said Mills A Brice his heirs and assigns forever the
 following ^{personally} property to wit: 1 bed and furniture & chair and bureau, 1 Mahogany Table 1 pair
 ditto 1 pair and Irons, Shovel and long broom & bed 1 Tunnel Bed & furniture 1 soft spread
 Crochery ware 1 Churn 1 Pot 1 pan and 1 ear which articles are the same as purchased
 as above state: To have and to hold the above described property to the only proper use and
 behoof of him the aforesaid Mills A Brice his heirs and assigns forever: Upon trust nevertheless
 the said Mills A Brice his heirs executors and administrators shall permit the said Eliz: Woodard
 to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said property until default be made in
 payment or that the said John M Gurley shall suffer or be liable to suffer by his said bond
 -ship then it shall be the duty of the said Mills A Brice at the request of either of the parties
 their heirs executors or assigns to advertise and sell the above described property after
 giving due notice of the time and place of ^{such} sale first pay and satisfy all costs attending
 these presents secondly pay off said bond with the interest which may accrue and the
