This deed of bargain and sale from Jesse Turgess and wife to John C Beale was proved by the oath of James Haged one of the witnesses thereto and having been heretofore proved in the Clerk's office on the 21st day of March 1836 by the oaths of Alexander Majors and James Beale the other two witnesses thereto is together with the Certificate annexed of the proper examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

For the good will that I bear towards Ira Willons I have given him a life right to fifty acres or so much as may be contained in the following boundaries beginning on the whig Road and following the line of the land belonging to Richard B. Hollows until arriving at what is called the point field branch and following the meanders of said branch to a large poplar commencing again on the whig Road at a ground bridge between my house and where said Willons has located himself and thence a straight line to the poplar named making the road spoken of a line between myself and said Willons. But if at any time the said Willons should consent to lease rent or sell his right thereto that this shall not be at all binding on my part and that he said Willons shall forfeit his right to any land herein conveyed and if at a future time I should find it to my advantage to sell my land including that herein conveyed I agree to give said Willons for his improvements what any two discreet Men shall say they are worth acknowledged and witnessed this 12th of May 1840

This Indenture made the 26th day of July 1840 between Edwin Daughtery and his wife Jane Daughtery of the one part and Elisha Dardard of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edwin Daughtery and his wife Temperance in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand to him paid by the said E Dardard at or before the executing and delivery of these presents have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Elisha Dardard his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation 125 acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton State of Va and bounded as follows to wit on the east by the Cypress Swamp thence down to E Daughterys Line thence to Lawrence C Daughtery thence to Harrison Parkers thence to Elisha Dardard down to said Cypress Swamp together with all the buildings Timber and other appurtenances whatsoever to the said Elisha Dardard. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all the appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto every part and parcel thereof with every of their right members and appurtenances unto the said E Dardard his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edwin Daughtery beholds of hand the said E Dardard his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edwin Daughtery and his wife the tract or parcel of Land with all and singular appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Elisha Dardard his heirs and assigns forever from and against the claim or claims of them the said E Daughtery and wife and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well use and warrant and forever defend by these presents.
