This Inventory made this 13th day of May in the year of our Lord 1840 between John Lewis
and his wife Catherine Lewis of the one part and William Harris of the other part all of the
County of Southampton State of Virginia and Parish of Notoway Wethersfield that the said John
Lewis & Catherine his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Twelve dollars of lawful
of Virginia to stand in hand paid by the said William Harris at or before the making and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold
and by these presents do and each of them bargain and sell unto unto the said William
Harris his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land Containing by estimation six
acres more or less and bounded as followeth beginning at a post oak a corner of William
Harris line (the land he purchased of Willis Nadd) thence a line of marked trees to a
land a corner in the poor house land thence a line of marked trees to a pine a corner of
Harris land and thence a line of marked trees to the beginning together with all and singular
the houses out houses buildings yards appurtenances way waters and water courses privileges
profits commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said
land belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same or any part thereof
To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises
herein before mentioned with every part and parcel unto the said William Harris
his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Lewis & Catherine his wife for them
selves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises
herein before mentioned unto the said William Harris his heirs and assigns forever
the Claws or Claws of and the said John Lewis & Catherine his wife or either
of them or their heirs and from all and every other person whatsoever shall well and
as warrant and power defined by these presents. And witness whereof the said John
