

said Anthony Williams his heirs or assigns shall permit the said John A Turner to remain in quiet and peaceful possession of the said Negro slaves before named and to take the hires and profits of their services to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of money before mentioned in whole or in part and there upon this further trust that the said Anthony Williams shall & will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he shall be requested by the said John Ivy and the said James D Westbrook or either of them their executors administrators or assigns so to do sell the said slaves before named or as many as shall satisfy this debt of public auction to the highest bidder for ready money after having fixed the time and place of sale at his own discretion & giving thirty days notice through one or more newspapers printed in the Town of Petersburg and also notified the same by advertisement at the door of the Court house of the County of Southampton one day Court day previous to the day of sale and out of the proceeds of sale shall after satisfying the expenses thereof and all other expenses attending the execution of this trust pay to the said John Ivy and James D Westbrook their executors administrators or assigns their respective debts aforesaid and the interest thereon on each part thereof as may be due and the balance if any shall pay to the said John A Turner his heirs executors administrators or assigns but if the whole of the said debt and accruing interest shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said John Ivy and James D Westbrook their executors administrators or assigns on or before the said 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1840 so that no default of payment of the said debt is made then this indenture shall be void or else remain in full force. I know all now by these presents that I James W Beale of the County of Dallas State of Alabama and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Edwin Waller of the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia hath granted bargained sold released and confirmed by these presents to grant bargained sold release and confirmed unto the said Edwin Waller all right title and interest which I have in and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and ninety five acres to be the same more or less which land was formerly the property of William Whorlitt also my interest in the slaves formerly the property of the said William Whorlitt to wit: forty six Billy and their increases likewise of all other interest of whatsoever kind which I have in the estate of the said William Whorlitt to have and to hold the interest aforesaid unto him the said Edwin Waller his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever. And I the said James W Beale do hereby warrant and defend the interest aforesaid fully tenanted to be conveyed unto the said Edwin Waller his heirs executors administrators and assigns against myself and those claiming under me but against the claims of no other person or persons whomsoever I am witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of August 1840
