

This Indenture made and executed this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Martha West widow of William Fowler and Scutchens West her husband of the first part and Edward Crumpler, all of the County of Hampshire and State of Va. Witnesseth that the said Martha West and Scutchens West her husband have for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Edward Crumpler the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold alienated and confirmed and by these presents bargained and sell alienate and confirmed unto the said Edward Crumpler his heirs executors and assigns all our interest in the said Wm Fowler's land viz. the down allotted the said Martha West in right of her former husband by the common assizes to allot the same viz. Sub D. Mufpenburg, Simon Mufpen and Jordan Community Containing Twenty Acres. And is bounded as follows: beginning at a Cedar corner of the John T. Croft's old tract then N 60° W 12 p. to a post near the Well thence N 50° W 14 p. Old ground corner of same in being thence down the run of the said Branch the various courses thereof to the corner in the line of the tract of belonging to the heirs of John T. Croft and thence the said line to the Beginning. To have and to hold all our interest in the said William Fowler's land viz. the aforesaid down Containing Twenty Acres forever free from all the Claim or Claims demand or demands of our heirs executors and assigns. And we do for our selves heirs executors and assigns defend the aforesaid down free from all the Claim or Claims demands or demands of either of us our heirs executors and assigns.
