 that by the land belonging to Samuel M Pond containing three hundred and thirty acres more or
 less also the piece of Wood land lying south of the said Road and bounded by the lands of
 William I Hood the land now in the occupancy of Mrs. Elizabeth Gorman containing seventy
 acres more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or
 appertaining and all the right title and interest of the said Samuel M Pond in and to the
 said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of land and premises. To have
 and to hold the said hereby granted tract or parcel of land and appurtenances unto the said
 James M. Pond his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of
 the said Saml M Pond his heirs and assigns forever. Upon Trust nevertheless that the said
 James M Pond his heirs and assigns shall permit the said Samuel M Pond to remain
 in quiet and peaceable possession of the said two tracts of land and premises and take the
 profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid
 mentioned debt either in whole or in part as to those due the said William I Hood as
 Bond or as security for the said Saml M Pond and then upon the further trust that he
 his heirs and assigns shall so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he or
 they shall think proper or the said William I Hood his heirs and assigns shall request all the
 said tracts of land and appurtenances or such part thereof as shall be sufficient to discharge
 the debts hereby intended to be secured upon such Terms as he the said William I Hood
 shall direct due notice of which having been given at least ten days previous to time of
 such sale at two or more public places in the County and out of the monies arising
 from such sale shall after discharging all expenses attending said sale pay over to Wm I Hood
 the amount due him as Bond or Bondsmen and also the debts for which he stands
