Brichton of the same County of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Richard Darden for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars lawful money to him secured to be paid by the said James E. Brichton which is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said James E. Brichton his heirs and assigns a certain lot of land situate in the Town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid commonly known as Ballys lot. Containing two thirds of an acre more or less known in the plot of said Town as N^o. bounded on the East by main Street on the West by Norway River on the South and North by John Vuguhunt late De^{ce} heirs and to hold the aforesaid lot of land together with the buildings and other improvements appurtenances and advantages whatsoever thereto belonging or in any wise appurtenant to him the said James E. Brichton his heirs and assigns. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said James E. Brichton his heirs and assigns forever: And the said Richard Darden hereby binds himself his heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend the title to the aforesaid lot of land buildings and other improvements appurtenances and advantages hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed unto the said James E.
