This Indenture made the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and forty between Joseph P. Holland of the County of Schoffaught in the state of Virg^a of the one part and Lemuel R. Robertson of the County of Southampton in the state of Va^a of the other part: witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid as well as for the consideration of the said debt of four hundred dollars and seventy five cents due the 10th day of November 1839 having been fully paid off and discharged to Edward M. Holland together with the legal interest thereon accruing, he the said Joseph P. Holland hath granted released and confirmed unto the said Lemuel R. Robertson his heirs executors administrators and assigns two certain negro slaves namely Boy named Dick and Girl named Matthy as mentioned in the deed of Trust bearing date the 10th day of November 1839 as well by reference to the ^{said} deed of Trust. To have and to hold the said negro slaves together with the future increase of the female afores^d unto the said Lemuel R. Robertson his heirs executors administrators or assigns forever. To and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lemuel R. Robertson his heirs or assigns forever. And the said Joseph P. Holland for himself and his heirs as trustee and as such only doth hereby forever release all right title and claim to the said negro slaves and release and convey from the title of them to the said Lemuel R. Robertson his heirs and assigns and warrant and defend against the claims or claims demand or demands of him the said Joseph P. Holland his heirs or assigns and of all and every other person or persons claiming by through or under him or them: In witness whereof the said Joseph P. Holland hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written -

Know all men by these presents that we Samuel H Holmes and Benjamin Griffin are held and firmly bound unto the President and directors of the Literary fund and their successors in office in the just and full sum of two thousand sixty five dollars say four cents to which payment we and truly to be made to the said President and Directors of the Literary fund and their successors in office we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals undated this 16th day of November 1840
The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Samuel H Holmes was on the 15th day of October 1840 by the School Commissioning in and for the County of York
