This Indenture made the 10th day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and Forty between Thomas Damm and Sarah Jane his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part, and Samuel Raulings of the County of Sussex of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Thomas Damm and Sarah Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty three dollars and twenty five cents law full money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Raulings at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do and of them doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Samuel Raulings his heirs and assigns a certain tract piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by survey twenty nine acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a Red Oak in Richard Pinner's line thence along his line N 35^o W 87 pole to a Laurel and the Bear Branch a corner to the said Samuel Raulings and the said Branch as it meanders to a Sweet Gum a corner to William Briggards along his line S 60^o E 16 pole S 60^o E 20 pole N 74^o E 16 pole to a Maple a new made corner to Collins Parkrough along his line nearly shaped and S 34^o W 87 pole to the beginning. Together with all and singular the appurtenances and promises and the reversions and reversings remainder and remainings yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof: To have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of Land with the appurtenances hereditamentally and all and singular other the promises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Samuel Raulings his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas Damm and Sarah Jane his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract piece or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances and promises before mentioned and the said Samuel Raulings his heirs and assigns have given the Quits or claims of them the said Thomas Damm and Sarah Jane his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents only.
